

WREC Abstract guidelines

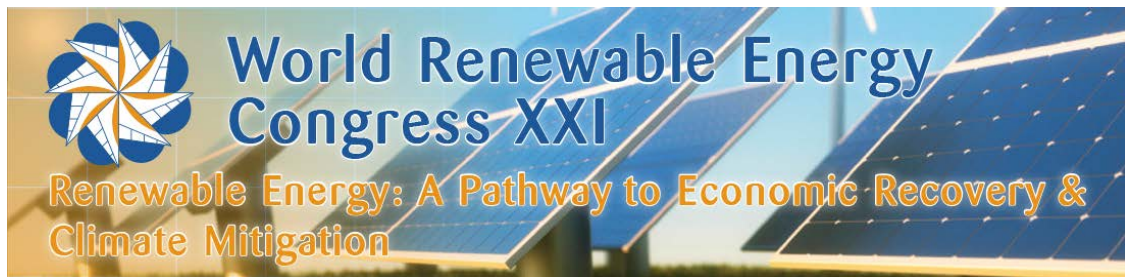
The World Renewable Energy Committee is currently inviting abstract submission for oral and poster presentation at the WREC 2022 meeting '*Renewable Energy: A Pathway to Economic Recovery & Climate Mitigation*'. This conference will take place between 6 -10, 2022 February at Murdoch University, Western Australia and will showcase recent advances and novel discoveries. In order to have your abstract considered for acceptance, you must submit before the abstract deadline of 15 July. Notification of abstract acceptance will be provided by 30 July. Further details of this exciting conference can be found on the website at www.wrec2022.com and details of the registration process will follow shortly.

Oral: Accepted abstracts for oral presentations will be allocated a 15 minute timeslot in the program with 5 minutes of questions and answers.

Posters: A poster is an alternative way to present at paper that has equal status within the Conference to an oral presentation. A poster presentation is designed to allow presenters maximum interaction with attendees. This is an excellent way of gaining feedback from interested and knowledgeable researchers and also very useful for extending your personal network of relevant researchers.

General Policies and Requirements

- All abstracts submitted for presentation must contain original research that has not been previously presented or scheduled for presentation, published or accepted for publication, and if under review, must not appear in print before the Conference
- All abstracts must be submitted online using the conference website
- Abstracts to be a maximum of 250 words
- The abstract should provide sufficient detail to accurately represent the intended presentation
- Completing the topic and type sections on the submission is required and will assist the committee in allocating the presentation if accepted
- At least one author for each abstract that is accepted for presentation in the Conference Program is expected to register and pay to attend the Conference to present their research. All of the costs to attend the Conference, including the registration fee, must be paid by presenters. WREC does not pay honoraria for any presentations
- The organising committee has the right to refuse or accept any submission as well as allocating the presentation type even if this differs from that applied for



Abstract & Poster Review Process

Abstracts submitted for presentation at the Conference will be reviewed. Authors will be advised of their acceptance and presentation type by 15 October 2022.

The review criteria include:

- Significance/importance of the topic
- Aims and objectives
- Quality of analysis/coherence of argument
- Relevance of findings for theory/policy/practice
- Clarity/readability
- Overall evaluation (including contribution)

Poster Presenters

For those selected to present their paper in poster format, it is expected that one of the presenting authors be present at their poster during the scheduled poster session to discuss their research with fellow delegates. Poster presentation board of 1.2 x 1.8 board space will be available.

As a commitment to attend and support the Conference, accepted presenters are expected to pay and register for the Conference before. All costs to attend the Conference, including the registration fee, must be met by the presenters.
